

THE NUBAR PACHA FOUNDATION - ARMENIAN SCHOLARSHIP CHARITY  
GUIDELINES FOR GRANTING BURSARIES.

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The Boghos NUBAR Pacha Foundation - Armenian scholarship charity - is a private foundation acting under the Belgian law. It is the heir of the Armenian Scholarship charity, funded in 1924 by Boghos NUBAR Pacha.

Therefore, it contributes to the intellectual development of young Armenians who are willing to submit a doctoral thesis or to start a complementary specialization in a university or a higher education institute.

The Foundation grants students annual additional bursaries amounting to 2000,00 Euros provided they hold a Magna Cum Laude Master II degree or equivalent.

The doctoral thesis or specialization must be completed within two consecutive years.

All scholarship requests are to be written in english or French and be addressed to the Foundation's office of Secretary with a copy of the required degrees.

A questionnaire will then be submitted to the scholarship applicants who meet the necessary requirements. The latter will need to be sent back to the Foundation's Secretary office by May 1st at the very latest.

The Foundation's Board of Directors consists of two direct descendants of Boghos NUBAR Pacha, two university professors and three personalities of armenian origin. It meets every year, between May 15 and June 15, and awards the annual scholarships to the applicants who deserve it most. A special attention is given to studies intended to contribute to the blooming of Armenia or armenian culture.

The decisions of the Board of directors are final and without any appeal.

Any reluctance or false information noticed subsequently in the answers to the questionnaire may expose the beneficiary of a bursary to its withdrawal and the reimbursement of the already paid amounts

Every change within the financial situation of the beneficiaries must be reported without delay to the Secretary office.

The Foundation reserves the right to suspend, at any moment, the service of the bursary if the social behaviour or the lack of assiduity of the beneficiary justifies it. The Foundation decision is without appeal but is taken after the explanations of the involved party have been heard.

The beneficiaries of a bursary commit themselves to send to the Foundation's Secretary office a copy of their doctoral thesis or work. They are also invited to mention the received bursary and, later on, if they have the opportunity to do so, reimburse it so that other applicants may benefit from it too.
